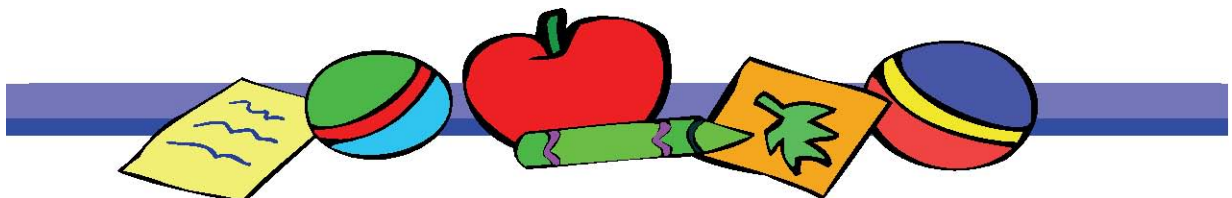
Preschool

The Preschool program is for both four and five year olds. Our all day program runs Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Our half day option is a five day program which runs from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The all day program provides extended care for working parents from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., if needed, at no additional charge.

Your assistance with early enrollment will enable us to better plan for a great school year. If you need different arrangements, please feel free to discuss them with our Preschool Director, Mrs. Sue Jordan.

Please review the information and contact the school office for an appointment to complete the enrollment procedure.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM AND EXTENDED CARE INFORMATION:

Five Day All Day Program -- Monday-Friday:

Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

\$120.00 (lunch included)

The five day program is the best option based on the extensive curriculum taught in our Preschool.

The All Day Program includes extended care for working parents, if needed. Hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. at no additional charge.

Five Day 1/2 Day Program -- Monday-Friday

Hours: 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

\$80.00 (lunch included)

We also will work with you, however, if you need alternative days.

Three Day All Day Program -- 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. \$95.00 (lunch included)

Three Day 1/2 Day Program -- 8:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. \$48.00 (lunch included)

NON-REFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEE:

\$30.00 per child

Fee is due upon registering your child.

NON-REFUNDABLE BOOK, MATERIALS AND RESOURCE FEE:

\$110.00 per child

Fees are due upon registering your child.

Please note: If a family has an older fulltime student in Kindergarten through 12th Grade enrolled at SCCS, a 20% discount will be given for a fulltime Preschool student.

2011-2012 PRESCHOOL PROGRAM INFORMATION



Weekly payments are expected on Friday prior to the week of care your child will be receiving.

Monthly payments must be paid before the beginning of each month.

Payment may be given to Mrs. Jordan or the school office.

Checks should be made payable to SCCS.

The half day option is a three or five day program which runs from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Children must be picked up no later than 12:30 p.m. There will be a \$1.00 late charge for every minute a child is not picked up after 12:30 p.m.

The all day program runs Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Only the all day program provides extended care for working parents from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., if needed, at no additional charge. There will be a \$1.00 late charge for every minute a child is not picked up after 5:30 p.m.

The ½ day and alternative days will be scheduled at the time the child registers. The days cannot be changed or switched without approval from Mrs. Jordan.

The program is closed for major holidays: Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday, the Monday after Easter, Fourth of July, and Memorial Day.

Money may not be deducted for major holidays, your personal holidays, or snow days.

Closings or late start announcements are found on SNOWCAP or KTIV-TV Channel 4.



What parents can do for their child:

Make your child feel secure and wanted at all times

Set a good example

Teach him/her to dress and undress himself/herself

Include him/her in your conversations at the table

Teach the child their full name, address, and telephone number

Teach him/her to put away his/her toys without help

Sing songs and read books

Regularly go to the dentist and doctor

Show an interest in everything he/she does

Do not threaten with school or the teacher

Try to keep regular eating and sleeping hours

Remind him/her to say “please” and “thank you,” and teach a

few little courtesies in keeping with the child’s development

Try not to make comparisons with other children in the family or

neighborhood

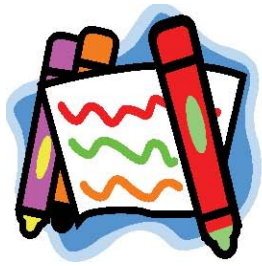
Teach the child to attend to toilet needs without assistance

Show the use of tissues or a handkerchief when coughing or sneezing

Keep up-to-date on immunizations and vaccinations

If you have any questions, misunderstandings, or concerns, discuss these with the teacher before telling others about them. Usually, difficulties can be ironed out quite easily when the approach is made in a Christian manner.
